**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, TO BE ADMITTED TO THE RWANDA
BAR ASSOCIATION**

1. Application Letter addressed to the President of the Rwanda Bar Association, (clearly indicating whether the application is for admission to the *Roll of Advocates* or the *List of Intern Advocates*).
2. Curriculum Vitae (CV): A comprehensive one and up-to-dated.
3. **Notarized Copy of Law Degree(s):** A notarized copy of a Bachelor's degree in Law or an equivalent qualification, as recognized by the Rwanda Higher Education Council.
4. Certified Copy of Postgraduate Diploma in Legal Practice (DLP) Or an equivalent qualification certified by the Rwanda Higher Education Council.
5. Proof of Identity: A clear and valid copy of the applicant's National ID or passport.
6. Valid Criminal Record Certificate: Issued by a competent authority and valid at the date of submission.
7. **Proof of Reciprocity (for Foreign Applicants):** Documentation demonstrating that Rwandan nationals are eligible for similar enrollment in the applicant's country of origin.
8. Statement of Non-Conviction: A signed and written declaration by the applicant confirming that they have never been subject to any disciplinary or administrative sanctions due to gross misconduct or criminal conviction, either in Rwanda or abroad, if previously convicted, that they have been officially pardoned or rehabilitated. The written declaration is attached to this call for application
9. Passport-Sized Photograph: One recent colored passport-size photo on a white background.
10. If the applicant is a practicing advocate in his/her home Country, he/she must present the letter of his/her Bar Association President/Law Society or his/her home Bar Association/ Law Society.



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11. Proof of Payment of Application Fee: A receipt or bank slip showing payment of the non-refundable application/processing fee of 350,000 Rwandan Francs (RWF), payable at the Bank Account No. **100012233196 (RWF) / Rwanda Bar Association opened Bank of Kigali (BK) / SWIFT Code: BKIGRWRW**
